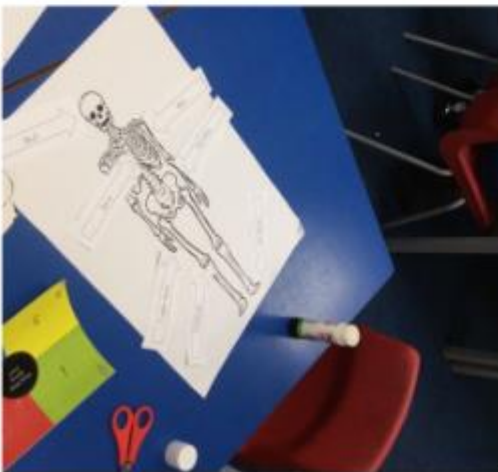

Year three have been learning about the settlement of Must Farm and have been enjoying our reading for pleasure sessions using book blankets.





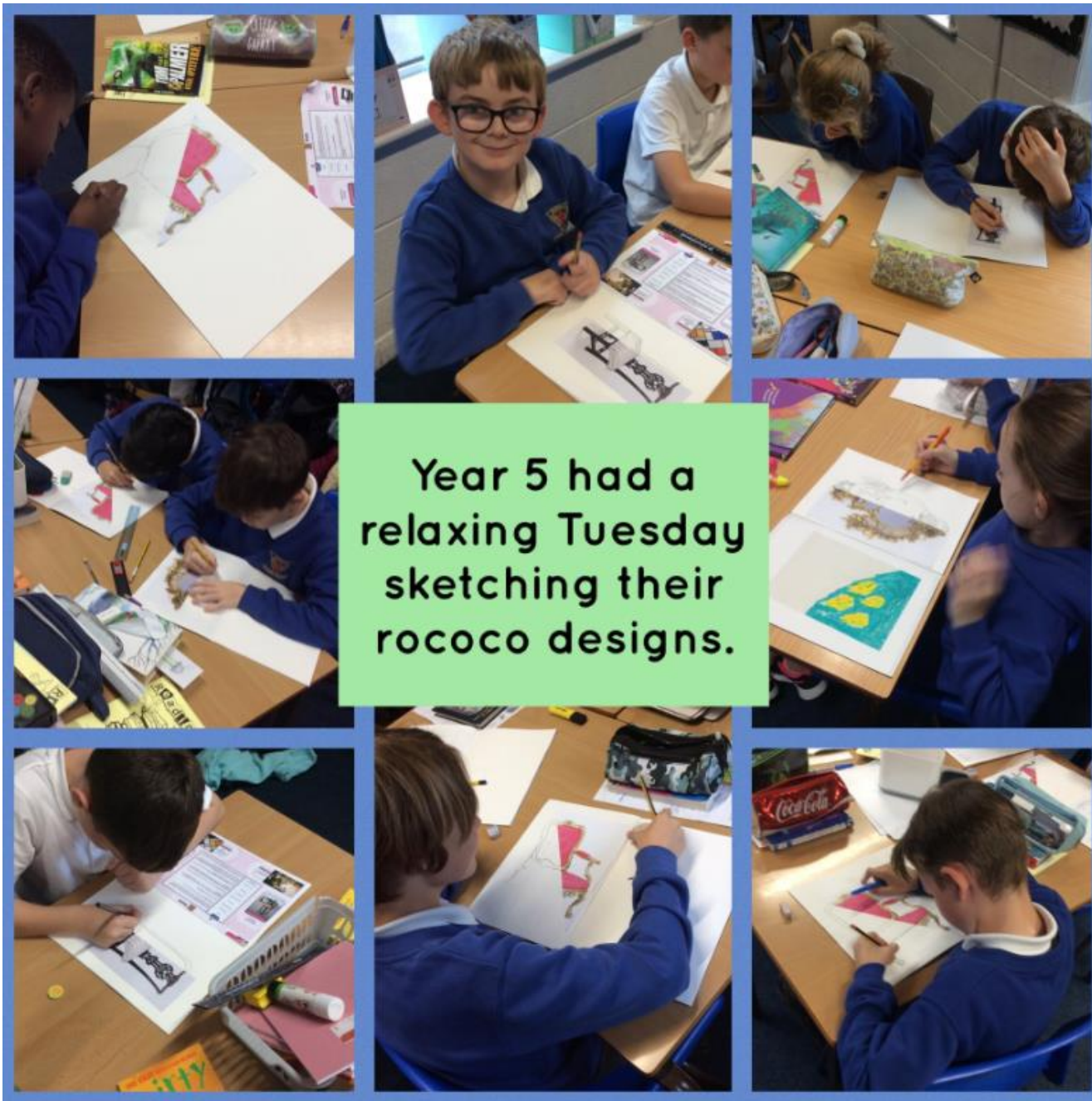
