Cheshire Football Finals – Year 5 & 6 boys

After our success at the Datastor cup, the boys qualified for the Cheshire Finals, which they attended last week. The boys had a bit of a slow start and narrowly lost their first game, 1 - 0, but soon started to show their true team spirit and potential. In the second game, the boys put on a great performance and demonstrated excellent determination and skills, finishing the game as comfortable 2 - 0 winners. In the final group game, once again, the team put on an excellent display and were much the stronger team. They conceded a goal against the run of play and then, despite how hard they tried, could not find the back of the net to equalise, despite creating a host of chances. In the end, the boys were incredibly unlucky not to progress but should hold their heads high for their efforts in a very challenging competition.

Cheshire Football Final Year 3 & 4 girls

There were many fantastic individual performances with the outstanding performances coming from Harper and Joshua.

Harper won both races (with a clear lead both times) and therefore was 1st overall. Joshua was 2nd in both races meaning a 2nd overall. Well done to all involved and congratulations to our individual achievers!

Year 6 and 6 Cross country

Our year 5 and 6 cross country runners participated in the second and final leg of the interschool cross country competition. Both the girls and the boys were in a strong position following the first leg. The conditions were muddy and cold, but all the children gave it their all and produced some super results. Both our girl and boy teams finished 1st, meaning that Mossley were the overall winners. Annabelle from year 5 (2nd) and Rafe from year 5 (3rd) achieved top three finishes. Well done to the whole team - we were incredibly proud of your efforts!

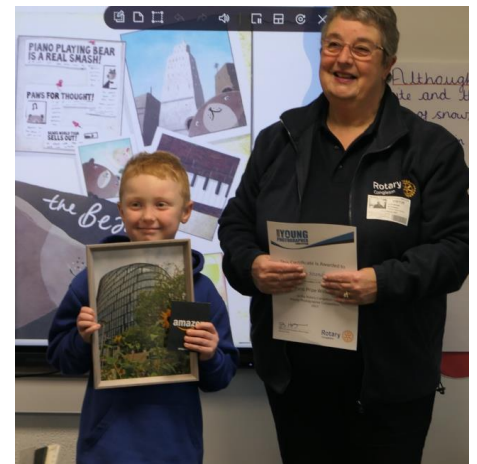
Visyon – Non uniform – 9/2/24
