# **CCTV**

Over the summer, CCTV was installed on our Key Stage 2 playground and the area by the school boiler house. This is now live. The decision to install the cameras was for the following reasons:

- protecting the School buildings and school assets, both during and after school hours:
- promoting the health and safety of staff, pupils and visitors as well as for monitoring student behaviour;
- preventing bullying;
- reducing the incidence of crime and anti-social behaviour (including theft and vandalism);
- supporting the police in a bid to deter and detect crime;
- assisting in identifying, apprehending and prosecuting offenders;

• ensuring that the School rules are respected so that the School can be properly managed.
